Local Crown Royalty

From the Seneschal of the Incipient Canton of Hawkes Reache

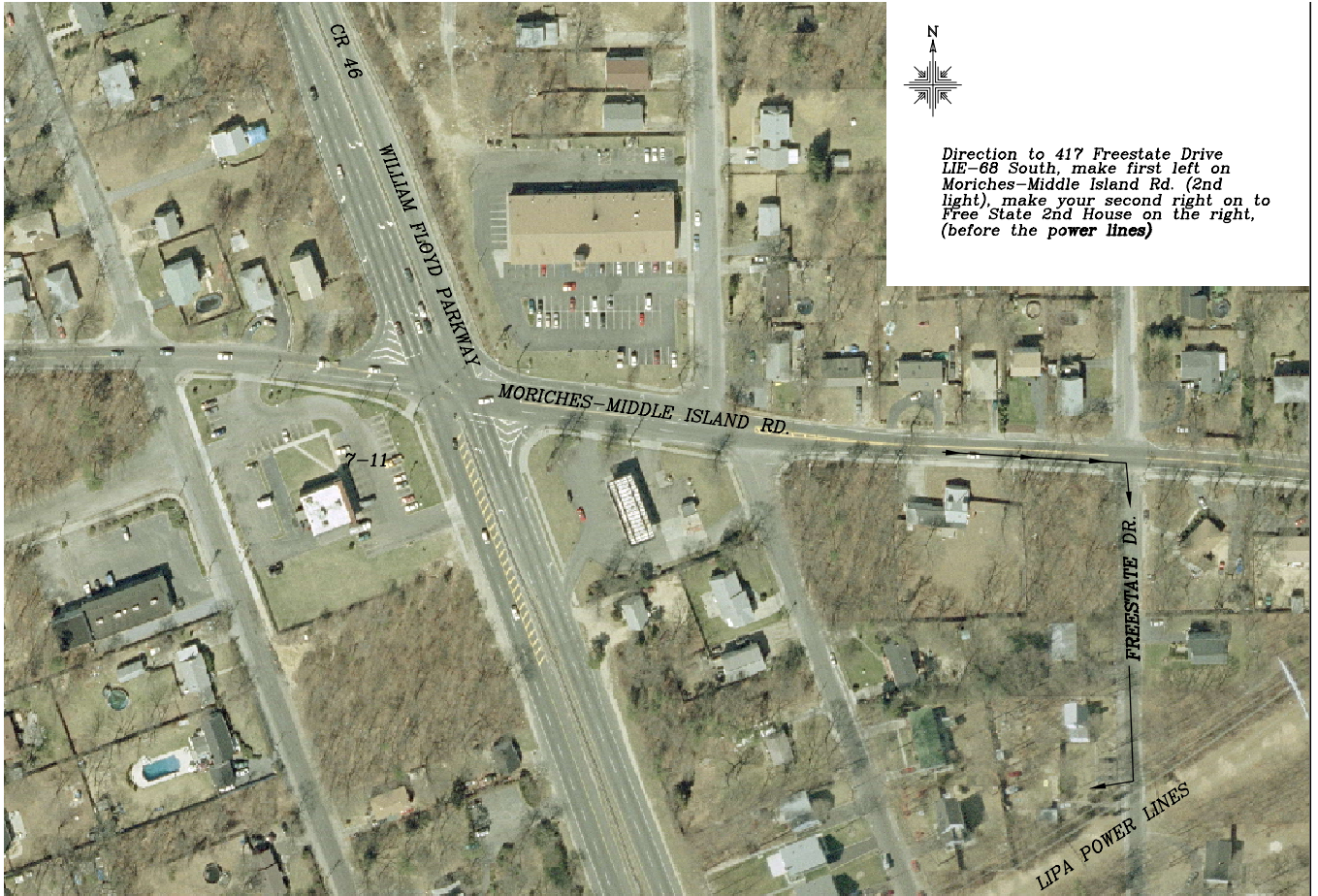

reetings unto the Populace,

This June finds many of us heavy into the thick of preparations for Pennsic. We ask that folks look to events where they might gain Valuable experience in the battlefield arts, whether martial, medicinal (chirurgeonate), or support-oriented (waterbearing), to better support our Barony and our Kingdom. For more local chances, local fight practices are listed elsewhere in the Viaduct.

Regarding Pennsic, at this point all folks looking to camp with the Barony should have registered with the Coopers as of May 31 (mail-in) and June 15 (online). Remember to submit your encampment paperwork and fees to us no later than June 30. (Note: Encampment paperwork deadline was extended from June 15.) Feel free to contact us with any questions you might have about the encampment.

This month also begins the polling for our successors. Master Ateno and his Lady Lassar have decided to make a bid for the position. It is our hope that they will continue our work in encouraging growth within the Barony. We would ask that any and all among the populace seek them out with any ideas or questions regarding issues of concern within the Barony.

As with any important election affecting your interests, we would hope that all members make the effort both to maintain their current memberships and to vote. This is your Barony and your chance to be heard. Please also remember to return your completed ballots, as the only counted ballot is a received ballot. Corpora states that we must receive a set percentage of votes back from amongst the eligible members (those with active memberships). All votes must be mailed back by no later than June 30 to be counted. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, we hope to have new Heirs to announce before Pennsic, making the transition a smooth one for the Barony.



On a last note, some thanks are in order. We would like to thank all those who participated in the Avalon Gardens demo last month. A good time was had by all. And to Lady Gisele, Lady Christine, and Erin for the Baronial heavy weapons tabards, and fencing doublets and breeches, they completed for the best-dressed teams (once again) at Balfar's Challenge.
